## ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20

- a) Online ISRO Quiz that on 24 August 2019, an online ISRO quiz was conducted for the students of Classes VIII, IX, X and XI. All Students present on 24 August 2019 participated in the Quiz Competition in batches.
- b) The appointment of Sh. R.B.S. Thapa as the new Principal and has joined the school w.e.f. 04 September 2019. Smt. Pallavi Thapa has joined the school as PRT (English) and Sh. Vivek Kumar Singh has joined the school as an Accountant.
- c) 146 Students have been registered for Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan, 2019 (VVM). The test dates for the same are 24<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> November 2019. One test has already been conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2019. Out of 146, 124 Students from VI to XI Standard have participated successfully in it. Balance students will take their tests on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2019.
- d) Parents Orientation Regarding Basic/Standard Mathematics of Class X.As per the CBSE directions for the Mathematics of Class X students, the school organized a Parent Orientation on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2019 in the School for the parents to discuss about the Basic and Standard Mathematics for their wards before submitting the List Of Candidate of Class X students to the Board. There are 22 students, who have opted for Standard Mathematics and 16 students, who have opted for Basis Mathematics.
- e) The finalization of List of Candidates of 38 Students of Class X for the Board Examination 2020.The list has been submitted to the Regional Office CBSE.
- f) Registration of 37 Students of Class IX and 26 Students of Class XI has been done successfully for the Class X and Class XII Board Examination 2021.
- g) School celebrated it as **Bapu Smaran Nidhi'** for a week. School students presented a show, where they performed very well. Students of Kindergarten showcased the Fancy Dress Competition. Different Inter House Competitions were organized like Declamation, Best Out Of Waste, Essays Writing and Display Board Decoration Competition. A Prabhat Pheri was conducted by children within school campus and some clothes were collected for distribution to needy.  
Winners were awarded prizes by the President SMC, Vice President SMC and School Manager. The prizes included books related to Mahatma Gandhi ji, Pocket Watch, Charkha and The Three Wise Monkeys.

- h) The Children's Day Cum The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Day Function of the School, which was celebrated on Thursday, the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2019, with élan, in the true tradition of Our Prestigious JSS. This time, the Theme was "NAVRAS", which were depicted in the form of India's Traditional Dances and Dance Dramas. A total of over 450 Children performed on the Stage. Entire Welcome & Reception, Ushering-In of the Guests, as also the entire Compering and Anchoring, and so on, was carried out by the Students. Over 1200 Parents & Guests witnessed the Function, including Shri Ranbir Singh Ji, RO CBSE, Dehradun Region as Chief Guest, along with his friend, Shri NB Bhatt Ji. He went around the School in detail on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2019.
